The signals were not good on any of the bands today, with some deep QSB. Propagation continues to be our biggest challenge on our last few outings!! But the weather was grand! The temperature was around 75 degrees with a light breeze, bright, blue skies....and several of us were able to get on the air...always a great time! After we finished, we adjourned to a local eatery to confer and hobnob over lunch.



Steve WB4OMM #5913 - Elecraft KX-3, Vibroplex Code Warrior Jr paddle, 5W to a ground mounted vertical Hamstick setup and a 53' End Fed Wire with a 9:1 Balun. Steve made a total of 4 Qs in 4 different states, including 2 NAQCC members on the following bands: 20M – WA2JSG, Curt #3457 in NJ; 30M – K5HQV, Ben #5724 in MS; 40M – W8IRT in VA; and 40M W4EAB in NC.

Art WB4MNK #5274 used a KX1 at 4 watts, ZM-2 tuner, end fed wire 27' long to the top of a 20' push up pole, counterpoise 16' long, Dirt Cheap paddle. Art made 6 Qs as follows: 20 meters N8BB, Werner #1692 in MI; WA2JSG, Curt #3457 in NJ; KA0ENU, Joe #178 in TN; and K2YGM, Bob #6159 in NY. On 30M: K2YGM, Bob #6159 in NY; and KD3CA, Don #6602, in PA. No photo of Art, he was the picture taker this month!!

Here's **Don K3RLL #1905** taking the "bench" approach....look closely, you can see his "antenna apparatus" in the background on the right. His "Felix the Cat" bag of tricks is in the foreground. Never can tell what might appear outta dat bag!

Don used his KX-3 with a 31' UNUN Vertical antenna. He made two contacts on 20M: One with member K3SWZ, Glenn #3793 in PA; and one with Special Event Station KG4Z in Nancy Mountain, NC. (by the **SOUTH** Carolina DX Assn!)





This is John KM4JTE #7966, our newest CW member.....he brings his gear, puts up an antenna, a practices copying code! He's gettin' there too! A real patient and meticulous fellow - Drives from Gainesville, over an hour away! Dedicated!!
